



Gibson Theatre School: Theatre Makeup 101 Workshop

Hello and Welcome to *Gibson Theatre School – Theatre Makeup 101!*

In this theatre makeup basics class you will learn how to design a face, prep skin, apply foundation, eye shadow, eye liner, mascara, blush, set makeup, properly remove makeup and care for your skin and tools. We will also try our hand at creating an old age face as well as male and female make up techniques (very helpful for actors that are playing a character of a different gender!). This class is open to students ages 10 – 18.

A few important details:

★ **Dates:** February 18, 25, and March 3, 2012 and runs from 1:30pm to 3:15pm.

Registration Deadline is February 4, 2012

★ **Pricing:** The cost for this 3 day class is \$70 plus a \$45 materials fee

★ **Instructor:** Sarah Jane O'Donnell will be teaching this course. Sarah holds a BFA in performing arts from Emerson College, Boston. While at Emerson she received film & theatre makeup training from Professor Mary Ellen Adams (the same instructor who first taught makeup artist Bobbi Brown). Sarah also spent 2 years managing Bella Sante Spa, and award winning day spa in Boston, MA.

★ **Materials:** Each student will receive a Mehron professional student kit which includes a pallet of cream makeup (foundation, highlight, contour), pencil, stipple sponge, face powder, sponges, powder puff, and fine line brush. A mascara will also be purchased for each student. Students will be able to take these kits home with them at the completion of the class. Classroom supplies will include eye shadow, blush, brushes, cold cream, sanitation products, extra sponges, etc.

Students need to bring a small hand towel and some may want to have a face cloth as well.

Please make sure to mark off the skin tone choices so we can make sure to have your kit for the first day.

★ **Classroom & Homework:** Each student will be required to arrive on time and set up their makeup station. Please make sure to come with a clean face (no makeup on).

Students will be asked to gather examples (photos) from magazines, books or internet showing old age, gender, and basic everyday makeup. These photos will be used in class as guides. Students will also be given a worksheet to help them design a face for their projects. This research and design will need to be done prior to arrival at class. Class time will be used for makeup instruction and application.

★ **First Assignment:** Our first day in the classroom will be tackling the basics of creating a face that stands out on stage. We will work on bringing out the eyes, cheek bones, and lips. Please gather a selection of images (3-5 pictures) that reflect a realistic day or night time look for your gender. The age of the person in the photos should be between 15 and 25. Photos like this should be easily found in fashion magazines or online. When choosing photos try to find elements of each face that you think would work well for your own. Male students: don't worry so much about finding male faces with make up on. Choose photos that clearly show the face. We are going to analyze the shape, contour, and shadow of the face and work on translating this with makeup.

★ **Cancellations/Refunds:** Prior to the first class all registrations will be refunded less the materials fee of \$45. On or after the date of the first class no further refunds will be issued. If you need to spread your registration payment out you will need to provide post dated cheques at the time of registration.
